


FY 2015 – 3rd Quarter Energy Report (TTUHSC El Paso)

TTUHSC buildings consumed 50 kBtu/sf in the 3^{rd} Quarter, which is expected to meet our institutional goal of keeping energy utilization index (EUI) value in the range of 226 and 250 kBtu/sf/yr. Water consumption intensity for the 3^{rd} quarter is 6.4 Gal/sf, which is within the limits of SECO (State Energy Conservation Office) water conservation guidelines.

- 1. In 3rd Quarter FY2015, Cooling Degree Days (CDD) has decreased by 12%, and Heating Degree Days (HDD) has decreased by 8%, as compared to 3rd Quarter FY2014.
- 2. Semi-Annual Energy Report for the campus was prepared and submitted to SECO.
- 3. We are in the process of renewing contract with the State General Land Office (GLO) to extend existing gas contract for two more years starting from September 1, 2015.
- 4. Lighting retrofit to use F28 & F25 T8 lamps, and occupancy sensors for automatic lighting control, are being implemented through maintenance, new construction and renovation projects.
- 5. New energy efficient LED lights are being tested for performance and reliability.
- 6. Upgrade existing direct digital control systems. This is being done as and when funding is available.
- 7. Total miles driven by vehicles in 3rd Quarter FY2015 have increased by 14% as compared to 3rd Quarter FY2014. But the total fuel cost for the quarter has decreased by over \$3,000 due to lower unit cost of gasoline.
