This vehicle will be used for materials transport purposes and has a fuel rating of 18/24. The second vehicle purchased was a Ford Crown Victoria 4-door sedan at a cost of \$18,481. This vehicle will be used for staff transport between regional locations and has a fuel rating of 17/25.
