TTUHSC had no intra-agency appropriation item transfers.

Schedule of Vehicles Purchased

TTUHSC purchased six vehicles. Three of these were funded wholly or partially with appropriated funds. The first vehicle purchased was a Ford 12 Passenger Van at a cost of \$19,630. This vehicle will be used for staff transport purposes in El Paso and has a fuel rating of 13/17. The second vehicle purchased was a Ford ¾ Ton Cargo Van at a cost of \$15,531. This vehicle will be used for material transport in Lubbock and does not have an EPA certified fuel rating. The third vehicle purchased was a Ford Expedition at a cost of \$26,399. This vehicle will be used for staff transport between Regional Campuses and in Lubbock and has an EPA certified fuel rating of 14/19. The three purchased with local or other funding included a 2007 Toyota Prius for Odessa Women, Infant, and Children program staff transport at a cost of \$21,441 with a fuel rating of 60/51, a 2008 Chevrolet Uplander for Amarillo Pharmacy staff transport at a cost of \$19,337 with a fuel rating of 16/23 and a 2008 Dodge Caravan for Correctional Health/Clements Unit staff transport at a cost of \$16,028, with a fuel rating of 19/26.

Indirect Cost Schedule

Schedule of Lump-Sum Vacation and Compensatory Leave

TTUHSC paid \$2,720,187 for lump-sum vacation and compensatory leave.
