Distance Learning Tuition and Fees

Students classified as Non-Residents of Texas who also reside outside the State of Texas will be assessed tuition and fees at the rates listed below if they are enrolled in online distance learning programs.

Out of state students enrolled in a distance learning program pay a flat fee of \$524 per credit hour, which is \$1,572 per three hour course. A record processing fee of \$15, learning resource fee of \$9 per credit hour, and information technology fee of \$17.50 per credit hour will also be assessed each semester. A Malpractice Insurance Fee of \$17 will be assessed annually.
